

# Sound FX

MM2 Design Brief January 23, 2004

1. Using your video camera, record 5 or more different unique sounds. Keep the camera microphone close to the sound. The sounds can be a few seconds in length to half a minute. Be creative and record sounds we could possibly use in videos we make for class. Think of sounds you might hear in a comedy, cartoon, drama, suspense, horror film, etc. We don't need any more toilets flushing or telephone rings. Think of other sounds that might be used as ambient (surroundings, environment) noise when making a video. We will import these to iMovie and edit each sound separately and save them as an AIFF (sound) file to be used on a Multimedia Sound FX CD.

## Examples of Sounds we hear everyday

Walking on ice

Hammer hitting wood, metal, plastic

Crunching aluminum foil

Closing/Opening of a door, trunk, filing cabinet, garage door, gate, etc.

Clapping plastic cups together

Heater fan running at your home

Peddling a bicycle upside down

Marbles on an incline or in a board game

Ice being dropped in a bowl

Ball being hit by a tennis racquet

Train
